During the 2010-2012 GFWC Administration, clubs are encouraged to submit non-working time pieces which will be incorporated into the American Mural Project to represent GFWC member's volunteer efforts and the countless hours that members donate to their communities through their community service programs and projects. Clubs are encouraged to plan collection efforts around daylight savings time events: Fall Back 2010 & Spring Ahead 2011."

These thousands of watches will be encased in resin and intertwined together to form a huge watch link running throughout the three dimensional mural. What a way to honor GFWC and its thousands of hours of volunteer commitment to our country!
