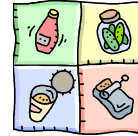

All submission to the contest must include the Community Improvement Contest Entry form/Cover Sheet, and your club must keep a project notebook with a narrative description of the project and all supporting materials (such as newspaper clipping, pictures, etc.) Your project notebook can weigh no more
